Reviewing the consequences of mega-events in the periphery, Matheson and Baade point out that spending on infrastructure is considerably higher in developing countries. Yet evidence suggests that the construction of stadiums in Japan, associated with the 2002 co-hosted World Cup with Korea, may rather have been "steroids, bloating rather than strengthening the economy" (McCormack, cited in Horne 2004 :1242).

Mega-events typically cost hundreds of millions if not billions of US dollars. That is, money that goes into infrastructure required for hosting the event, such as transport or venues, but also into the cost of organising the event itself, such as salaries, temporary overlays or security.
