After the guide coat is applied, we will use long sanding blocks to sand the guide coat off. What will happen is that the guide coat will sand off of the high spots, and will stay in place in any low spots. This will allow us to see any imperfections. If the low spots are low enough we will use a glaze to very lightly build up the surface.

Guide coat is like no build paint, sanding off with the least effort possible. Sanding verses Shaping. Both sanding and shaping are done using sand paper of different grits. Sanding is done to give the paint a good surface to adhere too with 220 and finer, higher numbered grit papers. Shaping is done with rougher paper in the neighborhood of 220 grit and lower and is the final stage of the body work. Sanding is really the first stage of surface prep.

How to get Perfect Body Panels with Block Sanding ...

For the pre-guidecoat sanding use the peel as your guidecoat. Cut the peel down so that only the pits are left using the 600-800 and then dry guidecoat and use p1000 to remove all of the guidecoat. After 1000 it's on to 1500 and 2000 and then buff.

P320 Sandpaper – When sanding between coats of polyurethane, P320 will wipe off any surface inconsistencies left from the finish. Also, wet sanding will generally use 320 as this practice requires a very fine grit as well. P400 Sandpaper – Only oil finishes like tung oil & teak oil require the surface to be finished to this level.
