For me, it's a great trail running route for a summer's evening. The route is not recommended for inexperienced hill runners because the terrain is rough and navigation can be challenging in mist. It also includes 820m of ascent. From the resort car park the route heads up the main track between the Funicular Station and the Day Lodge.
